## TRANSFER STUDENT INFORMATION

### For Eastern Iowa Community College Students

- Students who have earned the Associate of Arts degree at one of the Eastern Iowa Community Colleges (Clinton, Muscatine and Scott) will meet the Learning Perspective (LP) requirement at Augustana College. This does NOT include the Foreign Language, Christian Traditions Religion, Learning Community, Physical Education activities or the suffix requirements Q, G and D.
- All transfer credit to Augustana College must be earned with a grade of C or better.
- A minimum of 60 semester hours must be earned at Augustana College, excluding HPE courses.
- A maximum of 40 credits with the same subject code may apply toward graduation. Courses listed under more than one course code are counted toward the limit under each code.
- A maximum of 9 semester credits earned through distance education offered by an accredited undergraduate institution may be applied toward the Bachelor of Arts degree. Distance education includes but is not limited to 2-way audio/2-way video, open broadcast TV courses, and correspondence courses.

If a student enrolled at Augustana College wishes to return to the Eastern Iowa Community Colleges to take one or more courses, there is an approval process required by Augustana College. Students should contact the Registrar's Office at Augustana College to initiate the approval process.

#### GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

##### Writing Requirement (1 year college writing)

\_\_\_ Completion of college writing at Eastern Iowa Community College **or** first-year writing sequence at Augustana

##### Transfer Transitions Requirement (1 hour)

\_\_\_ Completion of LSC-300 (1 hour) Transfer Transitions course at Augustana College

##### Christian Traditions Requirement (3 hours)

\_\_\_ Completion of one 200-level course in Christian Traditions at Augustana College

##### Learning Community (4-6 hours)

\_\_\_ A pair of courses thematically/topically lined or successful completion of an approved foreign term. Learning Community courses also may satisfy LP or major requirements. Completion of LRCM-200 indicates completion of this requirement. The Learning Community requirement may not be met at Eastern Iowa Community Colleges.

##### Learning Perspective Requirement (33 credits)

For Eastern Iowa Community College students entering Augustana College in Fall 2010 or later, Learning Perspective requirements may be met by completion of the Associate of Arts Degree. Students not earning the AA degree will need to complete the Learning Perspectives requirements below.

\_\_\_ One course in each of the six Learning Perspectives (18 hours)

\_\_\_ Three additional courses in three different Learning Perspectives (9 hours). Students must take two different subject codes for courses within a perspective to complete the requirement. **NOTE: A maximum of two courses with the same subject code may count toward satisfying the total Learning Perspective distribution requirement.**

\_\_\_ Two additional courses in any Learning Perspective (6 hours)

### Foreign Language (0-9 hours)

- \_\_\_ Successful completion of the 103 or 201 course in any language at Augustana **or**
- \_\_\_ Equivalent (two semesters) at another college or university (141 and 142 of any foreign language at the Eastern Iowa Community Colleges)

### Physical Education (2 hours)

Any activity course at the Eastern Iowa Community Colleges will satisfy this requirement. PE courses do not count toward the 60 semester hours that must be completed at Augustana College.
