Transfer: Students who transfer to Upper Iowa with an A.A. or A.S. degree from a college of EICCD will be admitted to UIU with junior status, provided the student has earned at minimum a **2.70** Grade Point Average (GPA) for the Teacher Education Program. You can transfer up to **78** credits from an accredited two-year college or up to 90 credits from a four-year college when you join Upper Iowa as an undergraduate.

Foreign Language: UIU has no foreign language requirement

Admission to UIU Teacher Education Program: Upper Iowa University requires students pursuing an education degree earn a grade of **C or better in all EDU courses** in the Elementary Education major and endorsement(s).

Successful passage of the College-Basic Academic Skills(C-BASE) Exam or Praxis Core

Appropriate ratings from two student-selected instructional staff members on “Assessment of Dispositional Professional Qualities in Teacher Education Program Pre-service Educator: Admittance to Teacher Education Program”

Successfully complete EDU 110 Foundations of American Education with a C or above and complete the Foundations practicum (completed 20 hours, was prompt, scored “Fair” or better on personal attributes).

*As of October 2014, this class must be taken at UIU.
