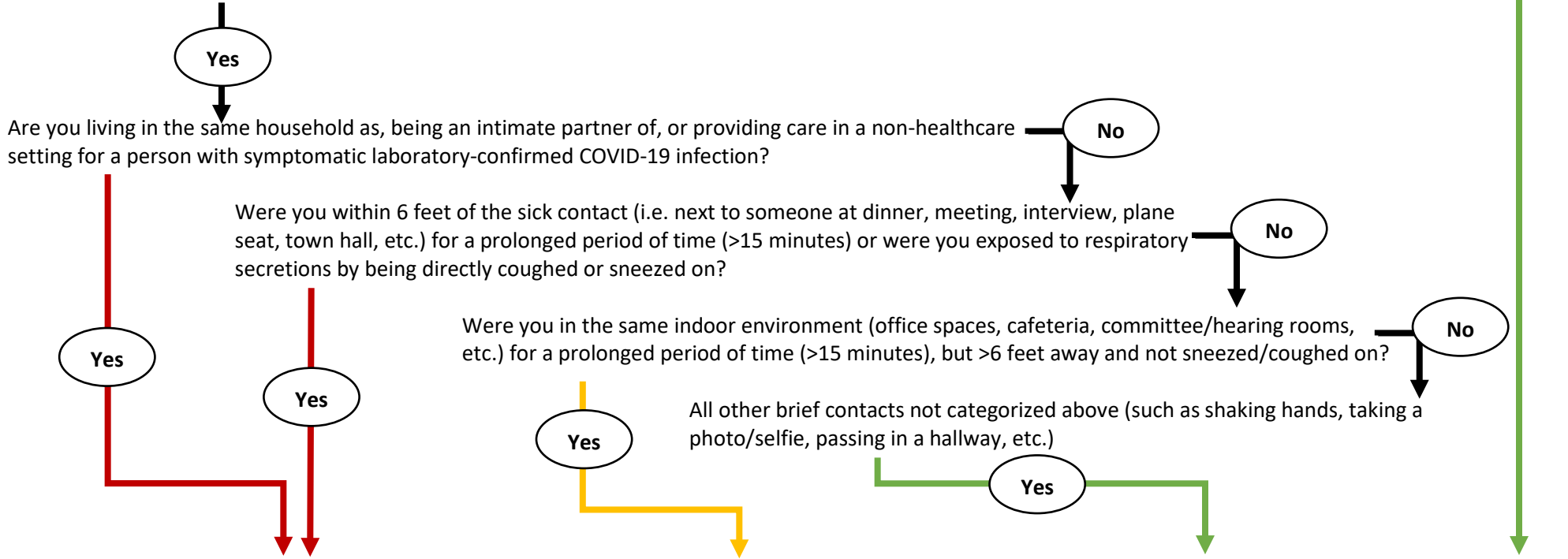


## RISK ASSESSMENT TOOL FOR CONTACT WITH COVID POSITIVE PERSON (adapted from CDC)

Have you been in direct\* contact with a person with a laboratory-confirmed case of COVID-19? (\*direct means person to person, NOT higher-order contacts such as a 'person who met a person who met a person that was sick')



	High/Medium Risk	Low Risk	No Identifiable Risk
<b>Asymptomatic People</b>	Stay home and avoid public activities; Expect 14 day self-quarantine. Notify Campus President and forward individual contact information to Dir. of HR. Recommend individual be tested for COVID-19.	Self-monitor symptoms for 14 days after exposure. Personal hygiene and social distancing in accord with recommendations for all members of the community.	Personal hygiene and social distancing in accord with recommendations for all members of the community.
<b>Symptomatic People</b> fever (> 100.4 F) and/or acute lower respiratory symptoms such as cough and shortness of breath	Immediately isolate at home; Pre-notify and consult health care provider for moderate/severe illness; Consult public health for evaluation; Notify Campus President and forward individual contact information to Dir. of HR. Expect 14 day self-quarantine. Recommend individual be tested for COVID19.	Immediately isolate at home; Pre-notify and consult health care provider for moderate/severe illness; Consult public health for evaluation.	Immediately isolate at home; Pre-notify and consult health care provider for moderate/severe illness; Consult public health for evaluation.
