## Program Description

The Criminal Justice program prepares students to perform the duties of police and public security officers in law enforcement, corrections, and judicial service. Students will study topics such as patrol and investigative activities, traffic control, crowd control, public relations, witness interviewing, evidence collection and management, basic crime prevention methods, weapon and equipment operation and maintenance, report preparation, and other routine law enforcement responsibilities. Students completing the program will be prepared to enter the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy.
