

PRACTICAL NURSING

Program Description

The Practical Nursing program of study is 11-months/47 credit hours. Twenty-seven of the total number of credit hours is offered in Nursing. The PN cares for the sick, injured, convalescent, and disabled, under the supervision of physicians and registered nurses. With just one year of formal preparation in the Practical Nursing program, students are academically qualified to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) for Practical Nursing.

The clinical component of the course of study is a strength of the programs. There are two clinical days per week, on average. This is a combination of direct patient care, care conferences, observational experiences and nursing simulation laboratory experience.

The Nursing program is accredited by the Iowa Board of Nursing.
