

Transfer Assistance Guide

EICC: Clinton, Muscatine & Scott Community Colleges
The University of Iowa- Pre-Bachelor of Science in Nursing

An associate's degree (A.A. or A.S.) will transfer to the College of Nursing on a course by course basis. This means the University of Iowa will review each course you have completed to determine whether or not the course will be accepted as fulfilling a nursing program general education, prerequisite or elective course requirement. It is therefore very important that you select each course carefully.

The following courses will provide students with the best preparation for transfer to the University of Iowa College of Nursing. Due to the heavy concentration in science, an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree is an appropriate goal.

Please note: This document was accurate on the date it was prepared but may not reflect subsequent changes made by the University of Iowa or the Colleges of EICC. For this reason, this information should be used as a guide only, and should not replace consultation with your community college advisor and a University of Iowa adviser.

Admission: Admission to the College of Nursing is highly competitive; it requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. The College of Nursing only admits students for spring starts.

Application deadline is April 1 for study beginning in the spring semester of the following year.

Grade of "C" or higher is required in all courses. A "C-" is not acceptable.

Please note that certain coursework must be completed at the time of application and again at the time study begins at the U of I. World Language: Four (4) years of high school or four semesters of college in the same foreign language (fourth- level proficiency); OR two years of high school or two semesters of college in two different foreign languages (second-level proficiency in two foreign languages). American Sign Language can be completed to meet this requirement.

Physics Requirement: Students are required to have 1 year of high school physics or 1 semester of physics in college. PHY:162 College Physics I will fulfill this requirement if you did not complete a year in high school.

*Note that one prerequisite course must be completed at the University of Iowa: NURS:3110- Healthcare Finance (3 credits). It is available online through the University of Iowa. This course must be completed along with the 64 credit hours of prerequisite courses prior to starting the BSN program.
